What is the Maker Faire?

The maker movement is a global event and also referred to by many as the greatest SHOW-AND-TELL on earth. It is a showcase for anyone who is embracing the DIY or do-it-yourself (or do-it-together!) spirit and wants to share their accomplishments with an appreciative audience and rub shoulders with other Makers. It is a place where hobbyists, tinkerers, artisans, craftspeople, and the merely curious gather together to celebrate, inspire, and get inspired!

The inaugural Maker Faire was held in San Mateo, CA, and in 2013 celebrated its eighth annual Bay Area event with more than 100,000 people in attendance. As Maker Faire grew in popularity and relevance, additional flagship Faires were launched in Detroit and New York City. Community-driven, independently produced Mini Maker Faire events are now being produced around the United States and the world, including Hong Kong, Seattle, Rome, and now Shanghai! A total of 93 Mini Faires graced the globe in 2013, compared to just 56 in 2012.

Jinqiao Mini Maker Faire 2015 hopes to showcase skills in science, technology, engineering, arts, cooking, painting, sculpturing and math. You will see workshops, music and performances, talks and presentations, all types of Makers from students to community to corporations. All Makers will showcase and share their skills and creations with the attendees.

Expected reach and audience

Last year we had 800+ community people attend the event with over 40 interactive maker booths. This year we really want to inspire our youth and support their passions in science, technology, engineering, mathematics, and the arts. Part of the STEM+A inspiration comes from bringing together other makers from the community: professionals from multinationals, local business leaders, educators, K-12 schools, universities, and hacker spaces.
